

I would like to point out just some of the my highlights in this auction. The choice for the front cover has been a difficult one with so many outstanding items to offer. On the quirky side [mine not the paintings], I was tempted to put on the front cover the Jim Nicholl painting or the unknown artist's rendition of a 'Stony Squaw'. The Illingworth Kerr large canvas is an important painting in my opinion and in some ways superior to the Kerr painting that sold for \$19,800 in 1990. The trend these days at auctions is that smaller is better so if you have large walls to fill, there are some bargains to be had. In five years of auctioning, I have been looking for Belmore Browne paintings. I have offered and sold two, the record price was set at our May auction and now in this auction I have three. Any one of the Group of Seven members, A.Y. Jackson, Francis Johnston or J.E.H. MacDonald could have gone on the front cover as could the W.J. Phillips or the Sybil Andrews. For sheer style [and price] Carl Rungius could have graced the cover again. But I decided on Calgary artist Ronald Spickett. This large and in my opinion, fine painting came out of a corporate collection and is one of the finest paintings by the artist to show up at auction in at least a decade.


