#### **AUCTIONEER'S NOTES**

Well, the last auction season of the millennium; unless you count 2001 as the real millennium [which no doubt some will try in order to repeat their marketing schemes]. I am reminded of the difference in this industry versus others by the interview of a curator in Europe when the Edward Munch painting 'The Scream' was stolen. To paraphrase, the interviewer was aghast that the work was stolen and might be lost forever. The curator said that the thieves would be crazy to hurt the work and it would probably show up again, maybe in 5 years, maybe in 50 years, maybe in 500 years; but it would reappear. He was right. In the art industry, the work is not looked on in terms of months or years but more like decades or longer. And in this auction, I am very pleased to be offering certain works which will probably be recognized for decades, or longer, as great examples of the artist's career. In alphabetical order, some superb paintings that come to mind are Max Bates 'Scarecrows', a classic painting from a seminal time period. Richard Ciccimarra 'Three Figures' obviously was highly thought of by his biographer, Frank Nowosad, and I would concur. The front cover image by Kenneth Lochhead 'Saskatchewan Jubilee' from 1955 is a classic of the artist's early Saskatchewan work and exceptionally rare. This painting could be included in a retrospective of the artist's work and could easily fit into any institutional collection in Canada. And while I said in the last auction catalogue that offering a Peter Whyte painting was rare, do not be misled by the four in this edition of the catalogue, they are still rare. The Untitled, Glacier Scene is a stunner. Considerable debate took place with Robin Sherritt over which should go on the front cover — a tough decision to be sure. I would also like to thank Robin for all her help since she started working at Levis Auctions — a great person and someone you can trust to discuss anything with.

We have also been honoured with some great consignments from the former law firm of MacKimmie Matthews. The consignments include an array of respected contemporary artists and possibly their first auction exposure. I am confident you will concur with the addition of these varied and interesting paintings. Additionally, I have received some fine works from the Estate of the prominent Victoria writer and collectors, Robin and Sylvia Skelton. Mr. Skelton was a legend in his time and will be remembered as author, teacher, artist and publisher/editor of the Malahat Review. Many of the paintings in their collection were acquired directly from the artists, such as the fine Maxwell Bates 'Figure with Flaq', which boasts a prestigious exhibition record.

Last but not least, please be advised that there has been a change in the Buyer's Premium to 15%, necessitated by the substantial increase in credit card purchases and the merchant fees associated with those sales, as well as rising costs in other areas.

A sincere thank-you to our consignors and clientele across the continent. Have a great fall season and Robin and I look forward to seeing or hearing from you at the auction.


