





Paul Kane is part of a select group of 19th century ethnological artists including Catlin, Miller, Rindisbacher and Karl Bodmer who recorded the unfamiliar landscapes and peoples of North America. Kane's historic overland trek (1846-1848) through the Rockies, to the Pacific and the Oregon Territory resulted in hundreds of sketches of the, as yet, undeveloped West. This portrait differs from Kane's field studies because the subject, Maungwudaus, is not a "primitive native" in awe of the artist's ability to produce a lifelike image. He represents, instead, the unstoppable process of "civilization" that was taking place in North America, a process that was further advanced in the East. Both the artist and the sitter had experienced the rapid changes caused by the ever increasing European presence in the "new world" and surprisingly, they had much in common. Born within a year or two of each other, both men had just completed major journey; Maungwudaus across the Atlantic to Europe and Kane across the Rockies to the Pacific. Kane had lived among the First Nations people of America and Maungwudaus had lived among the British and French in Europe. Both left written accounts of their experiences.

Kane emigrated from Ireland with his family in 1820. As a young man he apprenticed to a furniture maker and studied part-time at Upper Canada College under the drawing master, Thomas Drury. He earned money for a study trip to Europe (1841-1845) by painting portraits in the States, including one of Gen. Harrison of Mobile, Alabama. Kane returned home, having seen Catlin's "Indian Gallery" exhibit in London, with a clear goal in mind: "... to sketch pictures of the principal chiefs, and their original costumes, to illustrate their manners and customs, and to represent the scenery of an almost unknown country." After his arduous trip West, he painted commissioned canvases in his studio, including pieces for the Government of Canada, the Hudson's Bay Co. and George Allan. Kane's work received high critical acclaim at the 1855 World's Fair in Paris and his book, The Wanderings of an Artist, was an immediate best-seller when published in Britain in 1858.

Maungwudaus, an Ojibwa-speaking Mississauga born about 1811, was an imposing and charismatic figure standing over 6 feet tall. There is mention of him in various historical records until 1855, after which he disappears without a trace. In his youth he was converted, took the name George Henry and attended a Methodist mission school, eventually working at translation for the missions and the government for about 15 years. Maungwudaus then organized a dance troupe of Walpole Island Ojibwa who performed in Detroit, Cleveland, Buffalo, and New York before embarking for Europe (1845–1848). Joining Catlin and his "Indian Gallery" in France, the group performed for the French and Belgian monarchs. Sadly, two members died in Europe and the entrepreneurial adventure ended with personal tragedy for Maungwudaus, who buried three sons and his wife, Hannah Henry, in Britain. The diminished troupe barely survived a harrowing voyage back to North America.

Maungwudaus began marketing himself as a showman and native healer, as evidenced by a rare daguerreotype entitled "Dr. Maungwudaus" (National Portrait Gallery of Canada). After a lecture in Washington on April 2, 1850 he met with U.S. President Taylor. A year later Maungwudaus performed at St. Lawrence Hall, Toronto at which time he likely met the artist. Kane was working on a large commission for George Allan and another portrait entitled "Maun-qua-dous" was among the 100 canvases delivered to his patron in 1856. Allan's collection was later purchased by Sir Edmund Osler and now forms the core of the Royal Ontario Museum's extensive Kane holdings. The sketches and manuscripts from the Kane estate reside at the Stark Foundation in Texas and most of his commissioned works belong to museums. Maungwudaus, until recently misidentified as "Pine Tree", has been in the collection of the Royal Canadian Institute since the early 19th century and was recently on loan to the National Gallery of Canada.

This powerful portrait is a stunning portrayal of an intelligent and intriguing man skillfully executed by a historically important artist; two remarkable men with remarkable stories.

The most famous Steinway art case grand piano was ornately decorated by the English artist Sir Lawrence Alma Tadema in the late 1800's and sold for a record price at public auction. The first White House piano, serial number 100,000, is now on display at the Smithsonian Institute and another Steinway art case piano, serial number 300,000, currently resides in the East Room of the White House. Art case pianos have been designed for many of the most distinguished homes and hotels in the United States.

The model B (211 cm) was first introduced by the company in 1884, this gorgeous semi-grand piano was manufactured at the New York factory just six years later, on January 27, 1890. After spending many years in the United States, the piano was brought to Calgary where it sat for approximately 15 years until being restored in 1999.

The original art case design of this spectacular piano has been completely refinished, bringing out the warmth and lustre of the Brazilian rosewood. Pianos made of this lovely wood will become increasingly rare and valuable as it is no longer legal to harvest it for manufacturing purposes. The interior of the piano has also been painstakingly refurbished at the Steinway factory with genuine Steinway parts.
