His diaries from 1908 to 1928 are in the Archives of Ontario and the town of Lumsden in Saskatchewan is named after him. Though some of the pictures are of a personal nature, showing views of Scotland and of family life in the 1890's, most show various CPR bridge constructions and trestle works, survey parties outfitted for exploration at different camps, fishing and hunting scenes; a rare 2 part panorama shot of Edmonton possibly prior to 1882; very early shots of Calgary including the Hudson's Bay Co. store and the CPR station; piles of buffalo skulls in Saskatoon, Red River cart and tepees; railway camp scenes in the Roger's Pass and through to Nelson BC. The album ends with shots of Echo Beach in 1905.

These photographs document the back story and front line work of many great feats of engineering in Western Canada, considering the conditions often encountered: landslides, avalanches, numbing cold, terrifying inclines and precipitous river gorges, as well as the gentler side of life in a prominent Scottish Canadian family. A fascinating historical document.
