- **6.** We reserve the right to withdraw any property before the moment of sale.
- **7.** Unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer, all bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue.
- **8.** We reserve the right to reject any bid. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the Buyer. In the event of a dispute between bidders, or in the event of doubt on the part of us as to the validity of any bid, the auctioneer will have the final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the article in dispute. If any dispute arises after the sale, our sale record is conclusive.
- **9.** If the auctioneer decides without regard to the printed estimated price that any opening bid is below the value of the lot offered, he may reject the bid and withdraw the lot from the sale, and if, having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, he may reject the advance.

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
