





- 1. LEVIS Fine Art Auctions & Appraisals, or LEVIS or "we" refer, for all purposes relating to this auction, to the corporation LEVIS Fine Art Auctions & Appraisals, a Division of Artbank Incorporated.
- **2.** The total purchase price payable by the Buyer for each lot will include a Buyer's Premium of 17% on the Hammer Price of all Property sold.
- **3.** Goods and Services Tax of 5% will be charged on the Hammer Price and Buyer's Premium on all lots.
- **4.** Although LEVIS Fine Art Auctions & Appraisals take care and diligence in their catalogue of the lots offered for auction, all Property is sold "as is, where is basis" and neither we nor our agents, auctioneers or other personnel nor the Consignor make any warranties or representations as to the correctness of the catalogue or other descriptions contained therein, of the physical condition, size, authenticity, or quality. Prospective bidders should inspect the property before bidding to determine its condition, size and whether the purchaser acquires any reproduction rights in the property.
- **5.** Notwithstanding the preceding conditions, if within fourteen days of the sale of any art lot, the Buyer can provide us with the written opinion of two acknowledged experts stating that the art, as outlined in the glossary, is in effect misdescribed in substantial particular in the catalogue; and within fourteen days after such notice, the Buyer returns the lot to us in the same condition as when sold, we as agent for the Consignor will rescind the sale and refund the Purchase Price received by them. Due to the time requirements, expense and sometimes changing scholarly opinion of some artists' work, LEVIS cannot guarantee authenticity of paintings, drawings, graphic art or sculpture created before 1900.

- **6.** We reserve the right to withdraw any property before the moment of sale.
- 7. At the discretion of the Auction House, LEVIS or it's employees may execute bids on behalf of an absentee bidder, telephone bidder or employee. Neither the auction house nor its employees shall be liable to either the consignor or purchaser for any neglect or default in making or attempting such bids.
- **8.** Unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer, all bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue.
- **9.** We reserve the right to reject any bid. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the Buyer. In the event of a dispute between bidders, or in the event of doubt on the part of us as to the validity of any bid, the auctioneer will have the final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the article in dispute. If any dispute arises after the sale, our sale record is conclusive.
- **10.** If the auctioneer decides without regard to the printed estimated price that any opening bid is below the value of the lot offered, he may reject the bid and withdraw the lot from the sale, and if, having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, he may reject the advance and withdraw the lot from the sale.
- 11. On the fall of the auctioneer's hammer or indication of being sold, title to the offered lot will pass to the highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer, subject to conditions set forth herein, and such Buyer thereupon will pay the full purchase price thereof or such part as we may require. A Buyer's premium of 17% will be added to the hammer price of all Property sold. This premium is payable by all purchasers.

#### **GOODS AND SERVICES TAX**

Applicable GST/HST will be charged on the Hammer Price and on the Buyer's Premium.

#### **RESERVES**

A reserve is the confidential minimum price agreed between the seller and the auction house, below which the art work will not ordinarily be sold. We do not accept reserve prices that would exceed the printed estimate. As agents for the consignor, we may place a bid during the auction if the current bid is below the reserve on the lot being offered.

#### **ESTIMATES**

As a service to our clients, we provide an estimate for each lot based when possible upon previous auction results by the artist, which in our opinion, provides a reasonable guideline as to the expected selling price of the lot. These are only estimates and are not appraised values. In addition, estimates are arrived at well in advance of the publication of the catalogue, based upon information available at that time. For more detailed information on any particular lot, please contact the office. In the case of a lot with a reserve price, we do not allow the reserve to exceed the printed estimate.

#### REGISTRATION

You should arrive before the auction to register for the auction. You will receive a bid card with a unique number on it, your bidding number. Please ensure that you have established credit references before the auction.

#### **BIDDING**

If you are successful on a particular lot, you will be requested to show your bidder number.

#### ABSENTEE AND TELEPHONE BIDS

Sometimes it is not possible to attend an auction so written bids may be left with us to execute on your behalf at the auction. Absentee bids are written bids left with our staff (no later than 5 pm on the day before the auction) that indicate which item you want to bid on up to a maximum amount on your behalf. Of course this information is kept in the strictest confidence and we always endeavor to secure the item for the lowest possible amount. These bids are executed by our staff. Telephone bidding is also an alternative choice as it allows you to be on the phone with one of our staff as they relay the sale to you and bid at your direction. #### **PAYMENT**

Kitseukla is also known as Gitsequecla and Skeena Crossing, with various spellings of the former as the First Nations languages were non written languages originally.

Emily Carr first visited Kitseukla, as she titles it, on her major sketching trip of 1912, the summer after France. This ambitious sketching trip extended from Victoria up the Coast of BC through and past Kwakwaka'wakw villages to Prince Rupert and Tsimshian territories. Undaunted Carr travelled 180 km up the Skeena River in a paddlewheeler to the Gitxan villages in the vicinity of Hazelton, BC. She also crossed Hecate Strait to Haida Gwaii (Queen Charlotte Islands) and visited abandoned Haida villages, including Cumshewa, Tanu and Skedans. This productive trip served to inspire the artist for the remainder of her long and prolific career. Often referred to as 'The turning point' in her career Carr was invited to contribute more than 60 works to the groundbreaking Exhibition of West Coast Art: Native and Modern, co-curated by Marius Barbeau and National Gallery Director, Eric Brown, which opened in Ottawa in 1927. This exhibit brought Carr to Central Canada where she met and was befriended by Lawren Harris and other members of the Group of Seven, many of whom were also included in this exhibit. The approbation Carr received for her 'Indian Collection' and enthusiastic response by other artists as well as Marius Barbeau, motivated her to return to the First Nations villages of the BC Coast and Skeena River in 1928.

Carr's paintings of these villages in 1928 focus on the volume and form of the poles. Less attention is given to including an entire village as we see in her 1912 paintings, such as Totem Poles, Kitseukla, an oil on canvas which Carr gave to the people of Canada in the custodianship of the Vancouver Art Gallery. The style and brushwork of Carr's 1912 First Nations paintings place them in the Post Impressionist/Fauve school. The First Nations paintings created on and as a result of Carr's 1928 trip are an earthier darker palette with wider and longer brushstrokes in the Expressionist style which Carr was working within at the time. Carr steps closer to the poles, concentrating on sections of the poles to express the power of the whole.

Kitseukla, is typical of Carr's artistic aims in the summer of 1928. The poles can be read and are well documented in Marius Barbeau's work on Tsimshian (including Gitxan) totem poles. The well known flood story pole and grave box are among the memorial poles of this work. Carr focuses on the ancestor figure of the Frog pole and emphasizes the form with red outlining of eye, nose and mouth as is a hallmark of traditional Gitxan pole style. The signature is authentic and consistent with Carr's other 1928 paintings. The kind of watercolour paper and the size as well as the paint itself is consistent with other 1928 First Nations subject matter watercolours by Emily Carr. The McMichael Canadian Collection has the Emily Carr watercolour, Kitseyucla (variation on the spelling) created in 1928. Other comparable paintings in public collections can be found in the Royal BC Museum collection in Victoria, BC and the Glenbow Art Museum in Calgary among several others. There are two known oil on canvas works of this subject and date in private collections as well.

This is a very important Emily Carr painting as it is a specific and assured component of her 'Indian Collection' and although there are several 1928 paintings of the nearby villages of Kispiox, Kitwanga and Kitwancool (Gitanyow) there are fewer of Kitseukla. There is no doubt that this is the Skeena River, Gitxan Village of Kitseukla. In addition to the Barbeau field notes and publications there are collections of historic photos and also paintings of the village by A.Y. Jackson and Edwin Holgate from their visit there in 1926. What also adds to the importance of this painting is the superb provenance as the family, which bought numerous paintings from Emily Carr in 1937, still owns this work, three generations later. Cuthbert and Pippa Holmes of Victoria, BC amassed an impressive art collection and generously bestowed the Art Gallery of Greater Victoria with several Emily Carr paintings. The AGGV Archives contains thorough documentation on these works, such as Brittany Coast and Totem Walk, Sitka, which are two well known Carr paintings from the Holmes collection.
